

EVRSafe wins Dame Award

A South Australian company, EVRSafe Marine Technologies, has won the prestigious METS "Dame" award in Amsterdam, Holland for its ISS1040 Multi-Toxic Gas Sensory Detection System. This comes after being awarded the highly coveted "IBEX Innovation Award" in the USA.

EVRSafe 1040, a sophisticated, innovative, integrated multi-toxic gas sensory device can simultaneously detect gases such as carbon monoxide, butane, LPG, nitrous oxide and hydrocarbons.
